Background: Baltimore BASE Network



Baltimore BASE (Business Assistance and Support for Equity) Network is a collaborative of Baltimore City community-based, entrepreneurial support organizations that provides coordinated assistance focused on Covid-19 recovery to BIPOC-owned businesses.



April 2020 - June 2021

- **Technical Assistance Network** launches in April 2020 with city government, foundations, and six original cohort members focused on providing recovery application assistance.
- TA Network expands to 18 organizations providing outreach and technical assistance to help BIPOC-owned businesses apply for Covid recovery programs (e.g. PPP, EIDL, BDC grants)
- Partnerships with lenders and resource providers.
- Over the course of 15 months, TA Network helps approximately **3,000 small businesses access an estimated \$40 million** in direct assistance. 70% of businesses served are BIPOC-owned.

July 2021 - December 2021

- Bloomberg Mayors Challenge; best practice recognition; six-city innovative financing collaborative.
- Project team engages in four-month strategic planning process with Bloomberg coach.
- Baltimore BASE Network central to city's economic development strategy, Baltimore Together.
- BDC works with Mayors Office of Recovery Programs on Economic Recovery Fund.

January 2022 - December 2023

Implement \$12 million ARPA Economic Recovery Fund program for small businesses

ARPA Program: Baltimore BASE Network



- Mayors Office of Recovery Programs Economic Recovery Fund
- \$25 million fund to assist small businesses, nonprofits, hotels, child care centers, artists
- BDC administering the \$12 million small business portion via the Baltimore BASE Network

Technical Assistance & Outreach

- \$2.7 million in sub-grant agreements with 13 partners to provide technical assistance to BIPOC-owned small businesses with a focus on Covid recovery.
- Additional \$500,000 from The Rockefeller Foundation specifically for BIPOC outreach.
- Goal is to serve 7,000 businesses in 2022-23.

Small Business Grants

- \$8.4 million available for small business grants with specific priority criteria.
- Focus of grants on business development: e-commerce; marketing; legal/accounting/HR
- Round 1 currently in progress, applications under review, 730 applications received.

Small Business Vendor Directory

- Call for vendors to provide business development services as part of grants.
- Baltimore BASE Network building directory of qualified vendors for small business applicants.
- Prioritizing Baltimore City and BIPOC-owned vendors.

Ecosystem Coordination and Expanding Access to Capital

- Initiative is integrated with Network partners' program offerings.
- Build pipeline of businesses for CDFI and bank loans, other forms of capital.
